(Vail, CO) --- The eclectic “Davey B. Gravey’s Tiny Cinema” is coming to Vail on Tuesday, July 5th courtesy of Vail’s Art in Public Places. Enjoy the free short silent films projected in the glorious format of Super 8 film in this tiny four-seat mobile movie house. This one of a kind film experience will be at the entrance to the Lionshead Mall from 12:30 - 3:30 p.m. and on the International Bridge in Vail Village 4:30 - 7:30 p.m.

The intimate theater setting creates a unique experience for the audience. While viewing the silent classic short films something unexpected occurs. Davey B. Gravey chimes in with his live acoustic accompaniment playing his electric-ukulele scores to the films. Each film lasting approximately two minutes leaves the viewer with a nostalgic sense of film in our age of digital media.
