SIMPLE TIPS TO HELP HOMEOWNERS & HOAs WITH THE RECYCLING ORDINANCE

## **HOMEOWNERS & HOAs ON SINGLE**

**CONTAINER PICK-UP** are required to sign up for curbside recycling. Residents will pay for service according to the size of their trash container, and recycling is included. All containers must be wildlife-resistant and may be purchased through your waste hauler or local retailer.

HOAs ON DUMPSTER PICK-UP are asked to recycle on site, adding a recycling dumpster and containers for rental units.

Ordinance No. 6 calls for Community Wide Recycling regulations as of July, 2014. To assist the community with its full adoption, a 6-month transition period is in effect until January, 2015. Residents and HOAs are eligible for rebates on containers, signs, remodeling and other start-up costs. Low-income assistance and building permit waivers are also available. Apply for your rebate today, while funds are available, until December 1st, 2014!
