

Parking info

There is no parking at the Booth Lake Trailhead or anywhere in the surrounding neighborhood, violators will be ticketed and/or towed. Pick-up and drop-off are allowed. Services at the trailhead include a restroom, bike racks and ShiftBike e-bike share station (shift-bike.com).

Parking spaces are limited at other trailheads and are available on a first-come, first-served basis, including overnight parking. These spots fill quickly.

VAIL & LIONSHEAD PARKING STRUCTURES

Ideal for day hikers

Free day parking and \$35 overnight parking. Vehicles can stay parked no more than 14 days and must then exit garage. If you park in Lionshead, take a FREE in-town bus to the Covered Bridge stop in Vail Village.

RED SANDSTONE PARKING GARAGE

Ideal for overnight campers

Free day and \$15 overnight parking. Vehicles can stay parked no more than 14 days and must then exit garage.

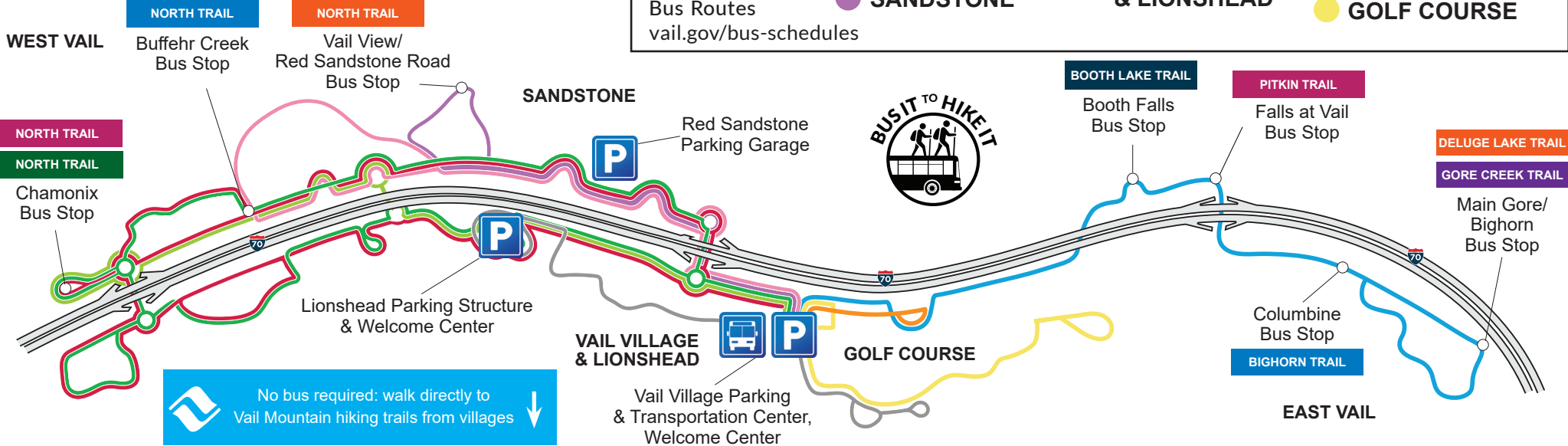

NORTH TRAIL
Trapper's Run

- Take West Vail Red bus
 - Get off at the **Chamonix** bus stop
 - Walk down N. Frontage Road for 200 yards
 - You will see the **Arosa Trailhead**

NORTH TRAIL
Cortina Lane to Buffehr Creek

- Take West Vail Red bus
 - Get off at the **Chamonix** bus stop
 - Walk up Chamonix Lane to Arosa Drive to Cortina Lane for one mile
 - You will see the **Davos Trailhead**

NORTH TRAIL
Buffehr Creek to Red Sandstone

- Take West Vail Red bus
 - Get off at the **Buffehr Creek** bus stop
 - Walk up Buffehr Creek Road ¼ mile
 - You will see the **Buffehr Creek Trailhead**

NORTH TRAIL
Red Sandstone to Son of Middle Creek

- Take Sandstone bus
 - Get off at the **Vail View/Red Sandstone** bus stop
 - Walk up Potato Patch Road to USFS Red Sandstone Road for 1 ¼ miles
 - You will see the **North Trail/Son of Middle Creek Trailhead**

BOOTH LAKE TRAIL

- Take East Vail or Hiker Express bus
 - Get off at the **Booth Falls** bus stop
 - Walk up Booth Falls Road ¼ mile
 - You will see the **Booth Lake Trailhead**

PITKIN TRAIL

- Take East Vail or Hiker Express bus
 - Get off at the **Falls at Vail** bus stop
 - Walk up Fall Line Drive ¼ mile
 - You will see the **Pitkin Trailhead**

BIGHORN TRAIL

- Take East Vail or Hiker Express bus
 - Get off at the **Columbine** bus stop
 - Walk north a ¼ mile up Columbine Drive (under the overpass)
 - You will see the **Bighorn Trailhead**

DELUGE LAKE TRAIL

GORE CREEK TRAIL

- Take East Vail or Hiker Express bus
 - Get off at the **Main Gore/Bighorn** bus stop
 - Walk east ½ of a mile up Bighorn Road (under the overpass)
 - You will see the **Deluge Lake/Gore Creek Trailhead**
