## A RESOLUTION OF THE VAIL TOWN COUNCIL EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020, the Governor of the State of Colorado recognized the COVID-19 pandemic and declared a state of emergency;

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the Town Manager declared a disaster emergency in and for the Town of Vail, Colorado, pursuant to the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act, C.R.S. § 24-33.5-701, et seq. (the "Act"), and Section 13.5 of the Town's Home Rule Charter;

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Town Council ratified the Town Manager's Declaration and extended it for 30 days;

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2020 and on May 5, 2020, the Town Council further extended the Town Manager's Declaration which is now set to expire on June 2, 2020; and

WHEREAS, of June 2, 2020 the Town Council further extended the Declaration to July 2, 2020;

WHEREAS, the emergency conditions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, as defined by C.R.S. § 24-33.5-702 and the Charter, persist and require additional and sustained action by the Town.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VAIL:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Declaration of a Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Vail, a copy of which is attached, is hereby extended to August 1, 2020.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Resolution shall take effect July 2, 2020
