11.16.1993	<p>REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION - Council Positions & 2 ballot questions</p> <p><u>BALLOT QUESTIONS:</u></p> <hr/> <p>QUESTION NO. 1</p> <p>SHALL THE TOWN OF VAIL BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT AND EXPEND THE FULL REVENUES GENERATED INCLUDING REDUCTION IN DEBT SERVICE DURING 1993 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT YEAR, [WHICH AMOUNT DOES NOT INCLUDE REVENUE GENERATED FROM AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES] WITHOUT ANY INCREASE IN SUCH TAX RATES AND TO SPEND SUCH REVENUES FOR DEBT SERVICE, MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS, AND CAPITAL PROJECTS, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1993?</p> <p>NOTHING IN THIS QUESTION CAN BE CONSTRUED TO REMOVE THE REMAINING RESTRICTIONS OF ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION WHICH IS COMMONLY KNOWN AS AMENDMENT ONE AND/OR THE TABOR AMENDMENT. 	<p>QUESTION NO. 2</p> <p>SHALL THE TOWN OF VAIL SALES TAXES BE INCREASED \$2,100,000.00 ANNUALLY BY THE IMPOSITION OF A NEW SALES TAX OF 0.9% ON RESTAURANTS AND BARS AND A NEW SALES TAX OF 1.8% ON LODGING BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 1994, AND EACH SUBSEQUENT YEAR AND SHALL THE TOWN OF VAIL DEBT BE INCREASED UP TO \$14,440,000.00 WITH A REPAYMENT COST OF \$27,617,690.00? THE ANNUAL REVENUES AND DEBT SHALL BE DESIGNATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MARKETING AND OPERATIONS OF A PERFORMANCE AND CONFERENCE CENTER. THE PORTION OF THE TAX THAT IS REQUIRED TO FINANCE THE DEBT OF THE REVENUE BONDS WILL EXPIRE WHEN THE DEBT IS RETIRED.</p> <p>THE REVENUES WILL BE COLLECTED AND RETAINED FOR NO LONGER THAN FOUR (4) YEARS CONTINGENT UPON THE BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION ON SUCH FACILITY AND IF SUCH CONSTRUCTION HAS NOT BEGUN BY DECEMBER 31, 1997, A VOTE TO DETERMINE THE DISPOSITION OF THE UNSPENT TAX REVENUES WILL BE HELD AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN NOVEMBER, 1998.</p> <p>SHALL DURING THE PERIOD OF COLLECTION AND RETENTION OF THE TAX, SUCH REVENUE NOT BE INCLUDED WITHIN THE GENERAL REVENUE OF THE TOWN OF VAIL AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH BONDS AND THE REVENUES FROM SUCH TAXES AND ANY EARNINGS FROM THE INVESTMENT OF SUCH PROCEEDS AND REVENUES BE COLLECTED AND SPENT WITHOUT LIMITATION OR CONDITION, NOTWITHSTANDING ARTICLE X, SECTION 20, AND WITHOUT LIMITING THE COLLECTION OR SPENDING OF OTHER REVENUES OR FUNDS BY THE TOWN OF VAIL UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20, OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?</p> <p>IT IS THE INTENTION THAT THE TAX REFERENCED ABOVE BE FULL REPAYMENT FOR THE BONDS.</p> <p>COUNCIL MEMBERS: 11.16.1993</p> <table data-bbox="283 1247 1102 1495"> <tr> <td>Paul R.
